First Steps:

1. Fill out a trip application online at https://woodsedge.churchcenter.com/people/forms/20407

- 2. Meet with Trip leader.
- 3. Check your passport. Is it valid? Is the bar code in good shape? The expiration date must have a 6 month window past your travel dates. http://passports.state.gov
- 4. Mark your calendar for all team meetings. Make them a priority. Let your team leader know if you cannot attend.
- 5. Start Fundraising. WoodsEdge recommends that you be prepared and willing to pay for at least some part of the trip yourself, but we also encourage fundraising/prayer letters as a great way to let people partner with you.

- Pray that God would send every child/family to this camp that he chooses.
- Ask the Lord for great weather and safety.
- Pray about your team and your role on the team
- Pray about unity on your team and hearts to serve

Example Daily Schedule:

Wake up at host home and have breakfast Travel to camp

8:30- Camp Devotional

9-12– grade school camp (includes small group time with discussion of biblical principles/gospel) 12-1– Lunch

1-4— High School camp (includes small group time with discussion of biblical principles/gospel) 4-5 Gospel presentation to parents Evening include some free with host homes for sight-seeing.

Q&A

What's the weather like?

How will be communicate?

There will be local translators provided. You don't need to know German!

Where will we stay?

We partner with Wilhemsburg Project which is a German, Free Evangelical church. The church provides host homes for us to stay in which provide breakfast and dinner.

Who attends the camp?

The camp is focused on kids from the community from kindergarten to High school. Because of the immigration crisis in Europe right now we expect to see many refugee and immigrant children as well!
