When: June 24-30, 2020

Purpose: Spend a week building relationships, sharing testimonies, engaging in community outreach, and participating in fun activities with young women rescued from abuse in Honduras.

Cost: \$1500

and exploitation.

Q: Do I need a passport/visa?

A: You must have a valid passport through December of 2020 (six months after the trip). Getting a new passport can take up to eight weeks, so if you do not have one, begin that process as soon as possible. A visa is not required to enter Honduras.

Q: Do I need any specific immunizations?

A: It is recommended that individuals have the following vaccines: hepatitis A and B, typhoid, meningitis, polio, MMR, Tdap, chickenpox, and influenza. Malaria prevention is recommended but not required. For more information, visit www.cdc.gov/travel.

Q: What does trip preparation look like?

A: Your trip leader will schedule and host six team meetings prior to the trip. These meetings are required and beneficial for team-building, safety, and spiritual/cultural preparedness.

Q: Where will we stay and what should I wear?

A: You will stay on site at a ministry guest house. Appropriate attire includes jeans, capris, t-shirts, lightweight jacket, and one outfit for church.

Q: What does a typical day look like?

A: The team will work together to complete projects and morning outreaches. The afternoon will be spent with the young girls at the home, and will include sharing meals, games, crafts, and devotionals.

Q: Will we have translators?

A: Yes!

Q. What does the trip cost include and when is it due?

A: Trip cost includes airfare, lodging, meals, supplies, and transportation. Free-day activities are not covered. Half of the total cost is due eight weeks before the trip, and the remaining amount is due two weeks prior to departure. Do not let the trip cost prevent you from going; the trip leader will provide resources for fundraising.
